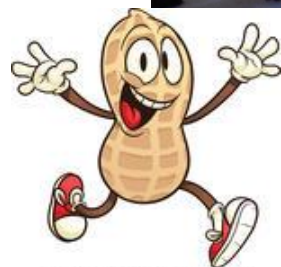




## Dookin' for apples with the children from Little Monkeys Nursery
